New Features for Agent 4.6.0

- → Power Tools Update to Read metadata from file and export logs
- → New Email activities Log the email classification and classification of attachments
- → SaaS authentication add support for different keycloak URL

- → Store visual markings position but revert other changes
- → Make the print in Outlook Configurable
- → Revamp metadata accessor
- → Agent Label is renamed to Endpoint on Dashboard

Bug Fixes for Agent 4.6.0

- → Japanese characters are not shown correctly in PDF Visual Markings
- → Meeting invites Two pop ups showing when Send update
- → Cannot open .msg files twice (file is in use)
- → Metadata not added to .vsdx files after classification
- → Right click classification not working for Arabic named PDF files
- → Created time shows as January 1, 1970
- → Enterprise Search Classification details are not available
- → SAVE CLASSIFIED operation still shows `Presentation1` as Filename and File Path
- → Prefix or Suffix in the subject still uses the tag name and not the alias
- → Classifier isn't displayed when forwarding the meeting
- → The scan does not complete when there is a large amount of files
- → Windows right-click classification doesn't write metadata or visual markings
- → No enforcement pop up message when unclassified .mov file is attached to email.
- → Visual tagging is duplicated when Send Update of meeting invitation
- → Visual marking overlapping when re-classifying PDF file with right-click
- → Explorer settings take precedence over plugin setting of allowing to deescalate the classification and distribution level
- → Power tools runtime error when retrieving agent config with diagnostic tools
- → Unclassified PDF is not classified when Classify attachments same as emails is selected

- → Clean up agent engine config for ED on uninstallation/upgrade
- → Scan was completed but queue continues to update with same files
- → Ribbon icon not updating when classifying the document
- → Metadata Refactor Fix CLI office app verb handling
- → Improve performance for subsequent scans
- → Agents in VDI environment are unable to connect to the server
- → PowerTools When fetching config through PowerTools, config is saved with field "visibleToAgent"
- → Database file access issues
- → When opening a classified file, classification is not reflected on ribbon
- → When tagging distribution, tag name is used and not alias
- → Email classification inheritance is not working as expected
- → Reclassified files are not getting updated in subsequent scans
- → Cache path is being displayed in the warning message instead of the file name
- → Custom alert message is not applied when tag is within a tag group
- → Right click classification and Endpoint Discovery not reading metadata correctly
- → Word Save as Pdf Pdf not classified6Recipient / Recipient domain not populated in Activity tab
- → Adjust auto-update check to ensure proper version gets downloaded and platforms not mixed
- → Text gets selected after clicking the save button
